

Preface

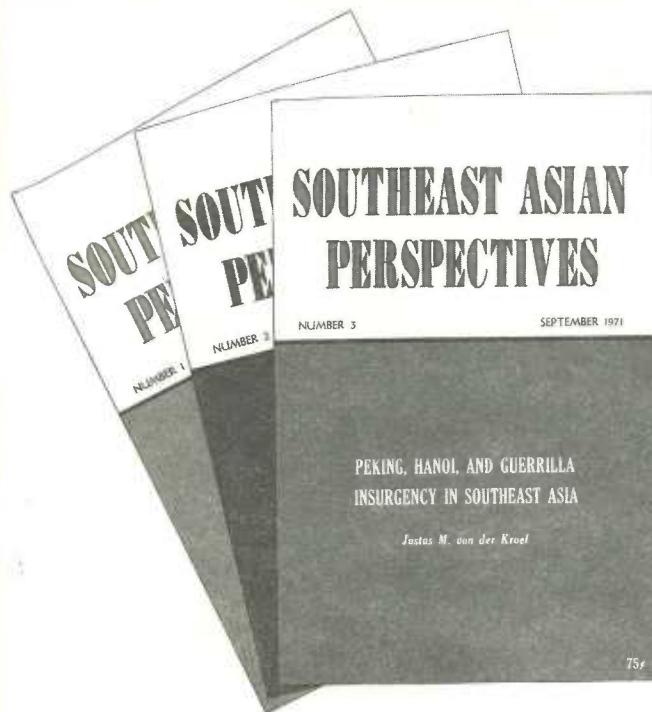
This issue of *Southeast Asian Perspectives* is in two parts. The monograph by Dr. Joseph Dunner on Israel and the People's Republic of China is a pioneering introductory study of relations between the two countries, and especially of Peking's consistently hostile policy toward the Jewish state, and its support for Arab guerrilla and other activity aimed at the destruction of Israel. The author has taught at Harvard, Grinnell College, and the University of Freiburg (Germany). Since 1964, he has been Professor and Chairman of the Department of Political Science at Yeshiva University, New York. Among his books is the standard *The Republic of Israel, Its History and Its Promise*.

We also publish in this issue Part Two of Dr. Gerald L. Steibel's monograph on Communist Expansion in Indochina, dealing with the Second Indochina War. Part One of this study, *The First Indochina War and After*, appeared in the June 1972 issue. Dr. Steibel is Director of Foreign Affairs of the Research Institute of America. He is the author of many articles on problems of communism and international relations.

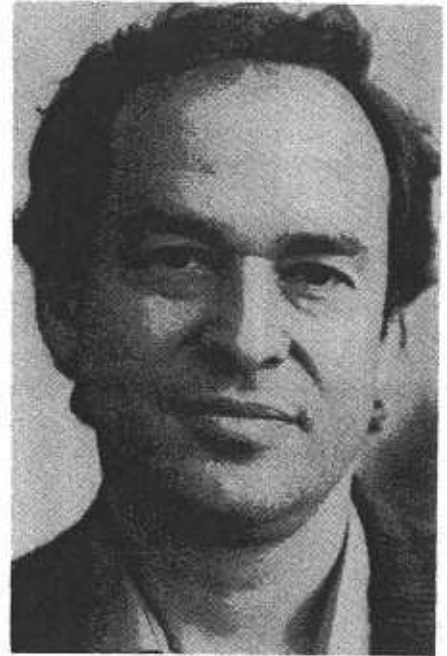

My Vietnam Lessons



Remarks

WHEN I SEE today's protestors, in the flush of youthful idealism, with their signs proclaiming "No Vietnams in Central America" a feeling of ineffable sadness overtakes me. For twenty years ago I was one of them. In 1962, as a student at Berkeley, I wrote the first book of New Left protest and helped to organize perhaps the first anti-war demonstration opposing President Kennedy's policies in Vietnam. In the mid-Sixties I went to England to work for Bertrand Russell and helped organize the International War Crimes Tribunal which brought American military actions under damning scrutiny but ignored analogous excesses by the North Vietnamese. While in England I also wrote *The Free World Colossus*, which identified America as the aggressor
